

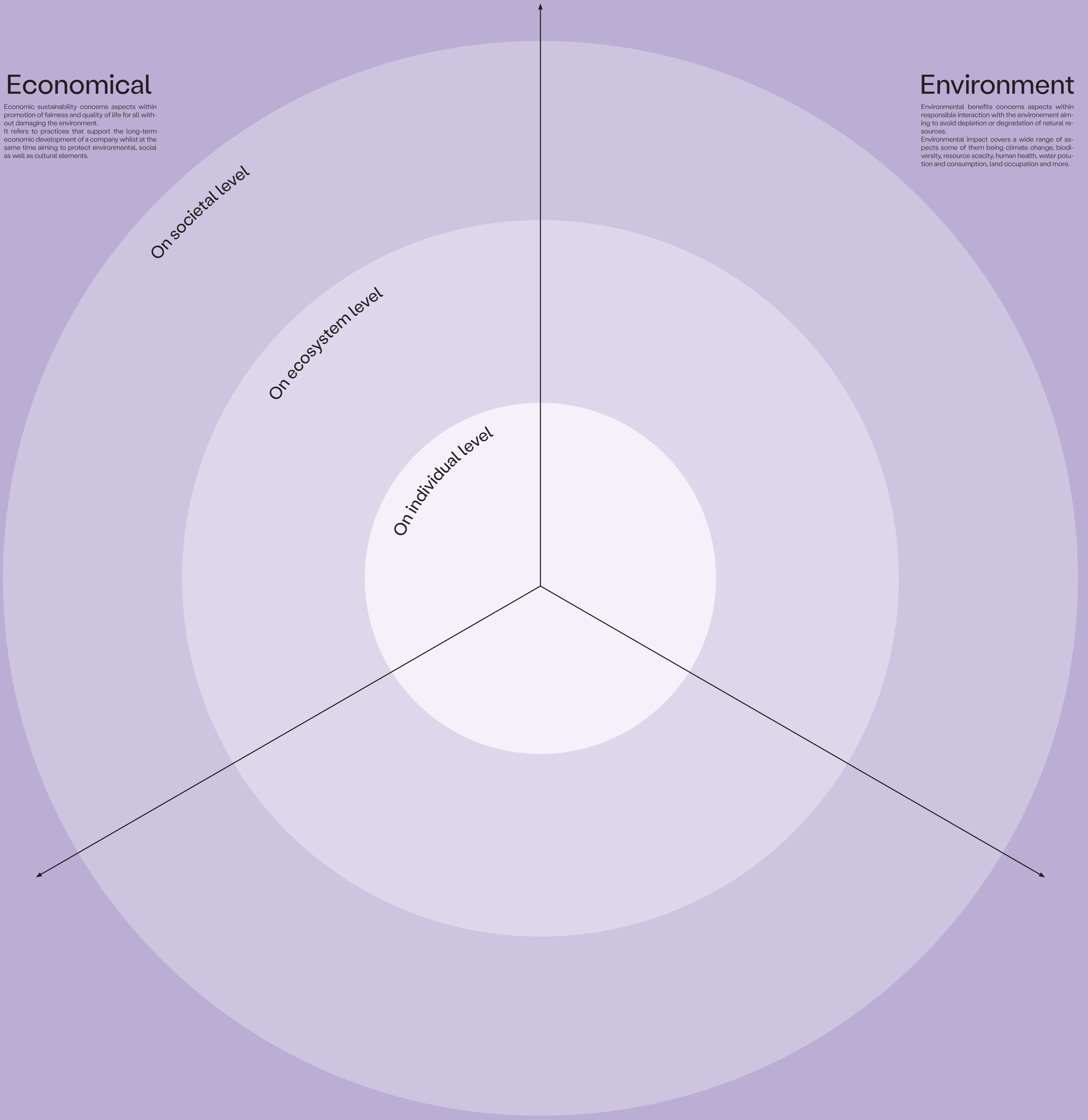
Circular Value Proposition
