



## Privacy policy – Submit for Danish Design Award

### 1.1 Controller

DDC – Danish Design Center is the data controller for the processing of your personal information when you submit for the Danish Design Award.

### 1.2 Contact Information

### 2.1 Purpose of processing of personal data

The overall purpose of the processing is to administer your registration for the Danish Design Award.

### 2.2 Legal grounds for processing

The processing of personal information is based on the agreement with you regarding your participation at Danish Design Award.

### 3.1 Categories of Recipients

Your personal information is disclosed to our data processors, such as email providers.

### 3.2 Categories of Recipients in Third Countries

Your personal information is not transferred to third countries. A third country is a country outside the EU/EEA, for example, the USA.

The information is not transferred to international organizations. An international organization is, for example, the UN, EU, or NATO.

### 4. Time frame for storage

Your personal information is processed for up to 12 months from the conclusion of the respective events that you may have registered for.

### 5. Obligations

We can only administer your participation in the event, if you provide us with contact information.

### 6.1 Rights

According to the data protection regulation, you have several rights regarding our processing of information about you.

#### 6.1.1 Right of access

You have the right to access the information that we process about you, including a reproduction of the information mentioned above.

#### 6.1.2 Right of Rectification (Correction)

You have the right to have incorrect information about yourself corrected.

#### 6.1.3 Right to Erasure

In certain cases, you have the right to have information about yourself deleted.

#### 6.1.4 Right to Restriction of Processing

In certain cases, you have the right to have the processing of your personal information restricted. If you have the right to restrict processing, we may in the future only process the information—except for storage—with your consent or for the establishment, exercise, or defense of legal claims, or to protect a person or important societal interests.

#### **6.1.5 Right to Objection**

In certain cases, you have the right to object to our processing of your personal information.

#### **6.1.6 Right to Data Portability**

In certain cases, you have the right to receive your personal information in a structured, commonly used, and machine-readable format and to have this personal information transferred from one data controller to another without hindrance.
